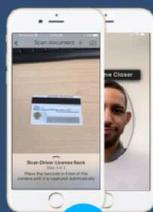


## How Does It Work?



1

Download Voatz & verify your device



2

Click "Verification Status" & verify your identity



3

Access Ballot, make selections & vote



After you vote, verify that it's counted correctly.



1

**Ballot Receipt**

Each ballot generated a voter-verified ballot receipt sent to the voter\* and signed with AnonID.



2

**Official Paper Ballot**

Each ballot produced a printable formatted for tabulation at the jurisdiction and signed with AnonID.



3

**Blockchain Data**

Each ballot's data was stored on the blockchain across blocks, depending on the timing of submission.

\* The jurisdiction gets an anonymized copy as well.
