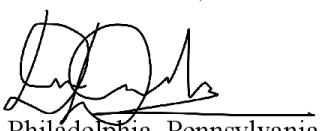
Accountant's Responsibility

Invoice totaling \$84,859 was double booked in discount and allowances, out of this \$76,727 related to 2023 is adjusted in 2023 comparative financials in Discount and allowances in Profit and Loss Account and in the Accounts Payable in Balance Sheet of 2023. The balance \$8,132 related to year prior to 2023, has been adjusted in Retained Earnings.

5. Lease Asset

Asset on finance Lease with BPO is classified as ROU Asset, as per ASC 842 finance lease, Lease Liability is recognized at the Present Value of future lease payments and ROU Asset is measured as the lease liability plus Initial direct cost.
