Tim is the CEO of Elevate Digital, a consultancy and web development firm that recently launched the SYNGINE.io (SYNergy enGINE) platform that supports small business development initiatives, with a focus on closing the wealth gap and expanding opportunity for underserved entrepreneurs in growth industries. Ascend Cities, a national program funded by JPM Chase's Small Business Forward, is utilizing the platform to support 500 businesses in 13 cities.

Before starting Elevate Digital, Tim was CEO of The BronxExchange, leading business ecosystem development in the Bronx, helping small businesses connect to resources, opportunities, and each other, in support of a more equitable economy. He developed and launched BECON (Business Ecosystem Navigator), a digital platform to support this work.

Tim was a founding team member and the technical architect of Charity Navigator, America's largest charity evaluator and go-to resource for philanthropists, leading design and development for 15 years. He started his professional career as a teacher in the Bronx as part of Teach For America, before joining the organization to lead development of the alumni network and connect thousands of alumni to the mission of ensuring every child has an equal opportunity to learn, grow, influence, and lead. Tim proudly serves on the national board of Family Promise and is on the advisory board for Manhattan College's School of Continuing Professional Studies.
